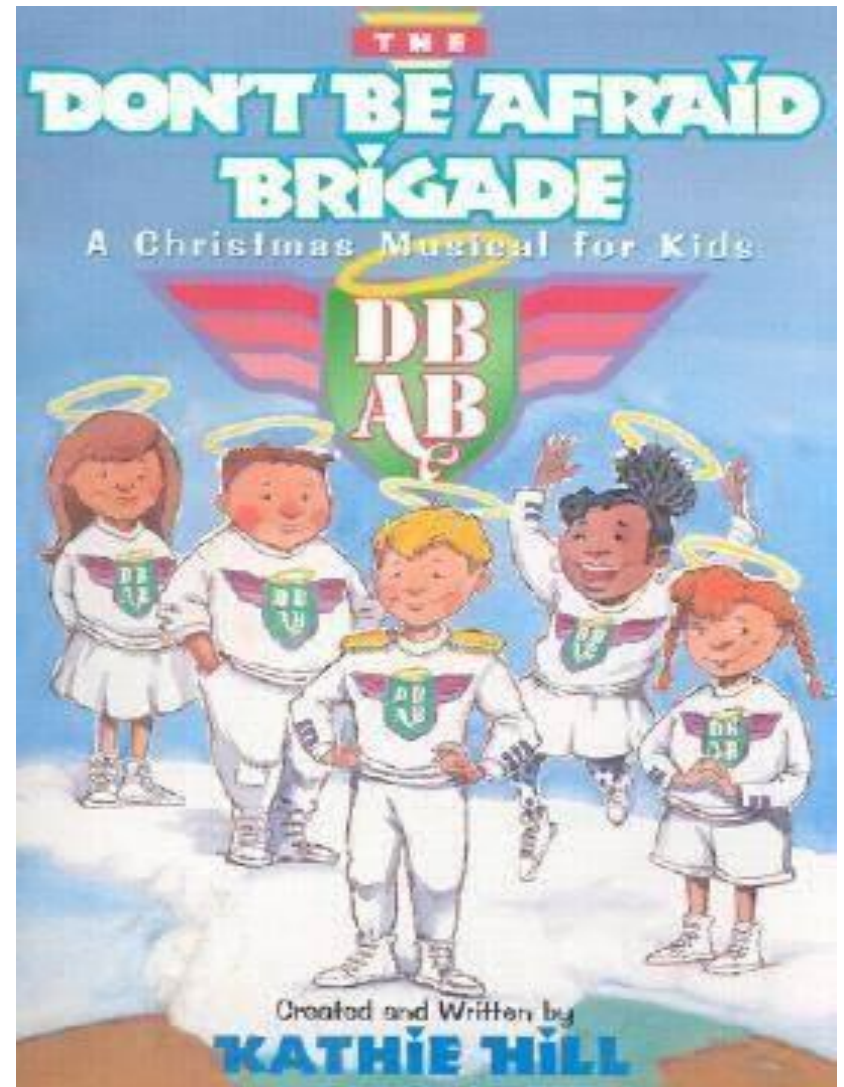
Thank you to our excellent sound and light man, George Melancon, who make us sound so great and who serves so well behind the scenes.
